Institution has an established ecosystem for innovations. It includes Central Instrumentation Cell (CIC), Research Centers (RC), Student's Study Circles, Student Development Committee (SDC), Cocurricular Committee, Eco-Club and Botanical Garden. These units act as Incubation Centers for tapping latent creative talents in students and faculty members. The details of the activities of these Incubation Centers are as follows:

Central Instrumental Cell: Our College has established Central Instrumental Cell (CIC) in 2015 to facilitate the research work among faculty and students. Cell provides instrumentation facilities and services with minimum maintenance charges for M. Sc. Projects and research work.

Research Laboratories and Centers: Research laboratories are approved by Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati for the subject Chemistry in the year 2012, Botany in the year 2013, Physics in the year 2014 and Research centers for the subjects Mathematics, Sociology in the year 2019, History & Marathi in 2021, Environmental Science & Computer Science in the year 2022.

Mohor-Annual Magazine: The College publishes Annual Magazine through active participation of students. An editorial board is constituted by selecting the students of having literary interest and talents. The board then motivates the student community to contribute to the magazine by writing articles, poems, stories etc. In this way "Mohor" becomes an incubation platform for the creativity of the students.

Co-curricular Committee: Through this cell students are motivated and guided for participation in intercollegiate student research convention AVISHKAR organized by SGBAU, Amravati for creative innovations for skill India. The College has been awarded number of prizes for research models and projects.

Students-Societies: Departments of English, Physics and Marathi publish Wall Magazines annually on the topics and the themes decided by the societies. The students of respective departments participate in creating the Wall-Magazines as follows: English Department through Lit Wall, Physics Department through Wall Magazine and by Marathi Department through Wall Magazine Beej-Ankure-Ankure.

Department of Botany and Environmental Science: Every year Wild Life Week Celebration is jointly organized by these Departments under Eco-club which attracts students from other colleges to actively participated in the competitions and programs.

Botanical Garden: The Institute has well-curated Botanical Garden under the Department of Botany. The students are encouraged to learn more about plant species by actively participating in field experiments in the garden.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE TUTOR


- The residential status of each ward:
 Parents/ relation/hosteller/staying in room must be maintained.
- The current communication address/email/cell no of the parents of the wards and alternate address/email/phone/cell no, if any.
- 03. The financial background of each ward & the hobbies (TV, Cinema, Sports etc.)
- 04. The current semester result status & the monthly test result of each ward (If passed - % of marks, If failed - in which subjects and no. of attempts)
- 05. Monitor the weaker student coaching progress of the wards and should ensure the passing of each weaker student.
- 06. Ensure that each ward gets the books/notes for all the subjects & submits the assignments and motivate to improve.
- 07. Try to identify the personal and family problem of each ward, if any.
- 08. The details of achievement of each ward (sports, academic & others) are collected and maintained for official & Committee usage.
- 09. Ensure that each ward pays the college fees/hostel fees/exam fees on time.
 The Tutor should have a continuous follow-up with the office about their wards dues, if any.
- 10. If a ward fails in any subject the tutor should arrange for remedial action so that the ward is helped to clear the arrear in the first reappearance.




Highlights of the TWS System:
