Preamble:

Importance:

The student feedback is very important to strengthen the quality of teaching learning environment and to look for opportunities to improve teacher's performance in classroom engagement with student to bring excellence in teaching and learning.

Process:

The students who are regular in the college are selected to provide the feedback. They are supplied with a pre-printed MCQ style questionnaire and a pre-printed blank option sheet to record their choices. A short counseling session of 5 minutes is conducted on how to feel up the option sheet and the meaning of various parameters is explained to participant students. It concludes with that the students have understood and satisfied with the questions appearing in the feedback form and understands learning values in terms of knowledge, concepts, skills, analytical abilities, etc. qualities of the teacher.

The recorded choices are then processed to obtain the feedback Analysis Report.

Submission:

The Feedback Analysis Report is discussed in staff council meeting and forwarded to IQAC for suggestions if any. Finally it is submitted to the College Development Committee (CDC) for its approval.

Action Taken:

If some teacher is observed performing below average (below 60%), he / she is communicated the suggestions to improve on respective low performing parameters till next feedback cycle.


